


PRAIRIE WOMEN'S SEWING CIRCLE

When we heard about this program from **Pam Buda of Heartspun Quilts**, we were immediately interested. I was never a good history student, but since I started to quilt (and the fact that we have a family member who is a great history teacher!) it hasn't seemed such a daunting subject. If you talk to the right person - someone who is passionate about the topic - history can be fascinating. That's the feeling we get from this program - Pam is passionate about the beginning days of quilting and wants to share that with anyone who wants to listen and that's what the PWSC is all about. With this program, we want to help you step back in time and put yourself in the shoes, worn tho they might be, of our quilting fore-mothers.

The program, however, was designed as a "come to the shop for a meeting" event. As we are coming into the winter months, it seemed that it would be a nightmare of rescheduling if the weather turned yucky, so we thought long and hard on how we could offer this information in a new format - thus our **Prairie Women Sewing Circle Goes Online!!!** With the help of our web guru and another family member who is tech-savvy (we have some talented guys in our family!), we have brought Material Rewards into your living room. Here's what registering for PWSC offers you:

- With your registration you will have an online login access to the PWSC. This is password protected and available only to registrants - **very exclusive!!!**
- The PWSC is a 6 month program with 6 different projects that highlight the "make do" techniques that were so prominent during the late 1800, early 1900's. There are also a couple bonus projects that will be discussed along the way.
- At the beginning of the month you will get in the mail (or you can pick up at the shop) a packet that includes the pattern for that month's project and some fabric that can be used in the project or in a future project. There might also be a surprise every now and again - just to keep you on your toes!!
- Each month you can view a new video, we made, designed to show you a new technique which is geared to what you will be working on for the month.



- You can also participate in the **PWSC blog**. We'll be chatting about the projects and how our lives are so different from the prairie women. This is also an area where you can **submit your photos** of progress on projects, quilts that you have that might have the "make do" technique, or other related photos. This will offer you a fun forum to stay in touch with the other girls, share thoughts and ideas or warn of troubles that you have had with a project (always good to be forewarned!!). You can submit to that page any time you choose.
- We would like to get together twice during the 6 month Journey - at the end of the first month and also after the last month. This way you can meet the other girls who will be journeying with you and you can ask any questions you might have. We'll also have some "well-loved" quilts on hand so that you can see the "make do" techniques first hand. These dates will be announced after the first month. You will receive an email with that information.
- We will also have a **mini-Material Rewards Store online with Pam's other designs or new reproduction fabrics** that have come into the shop. If you love the designs of the PWSC Journey One, you'll really enjoy some of her other patterns as well. We will also have fabric kits available for each of the projects offered to the PWSC participants at a great price.

Wow! That's a lot- and the really good news is that it is only \$35 for the 6 month Journey. If you need to have your packets shipped to you, we will do a 1 time \$20 to cover the 6 months.

So jump in the wagon! We hope that the ride won't get too bumpy, but it is definitely gonna be wild. You can either stop in the shop to register, give us a call or send an email and we'll get you signed up. We'll need some basic information from you - email address and such, and then we get on the road and start Journey One!!!

We'll be taking registrations from now until October 1st.
