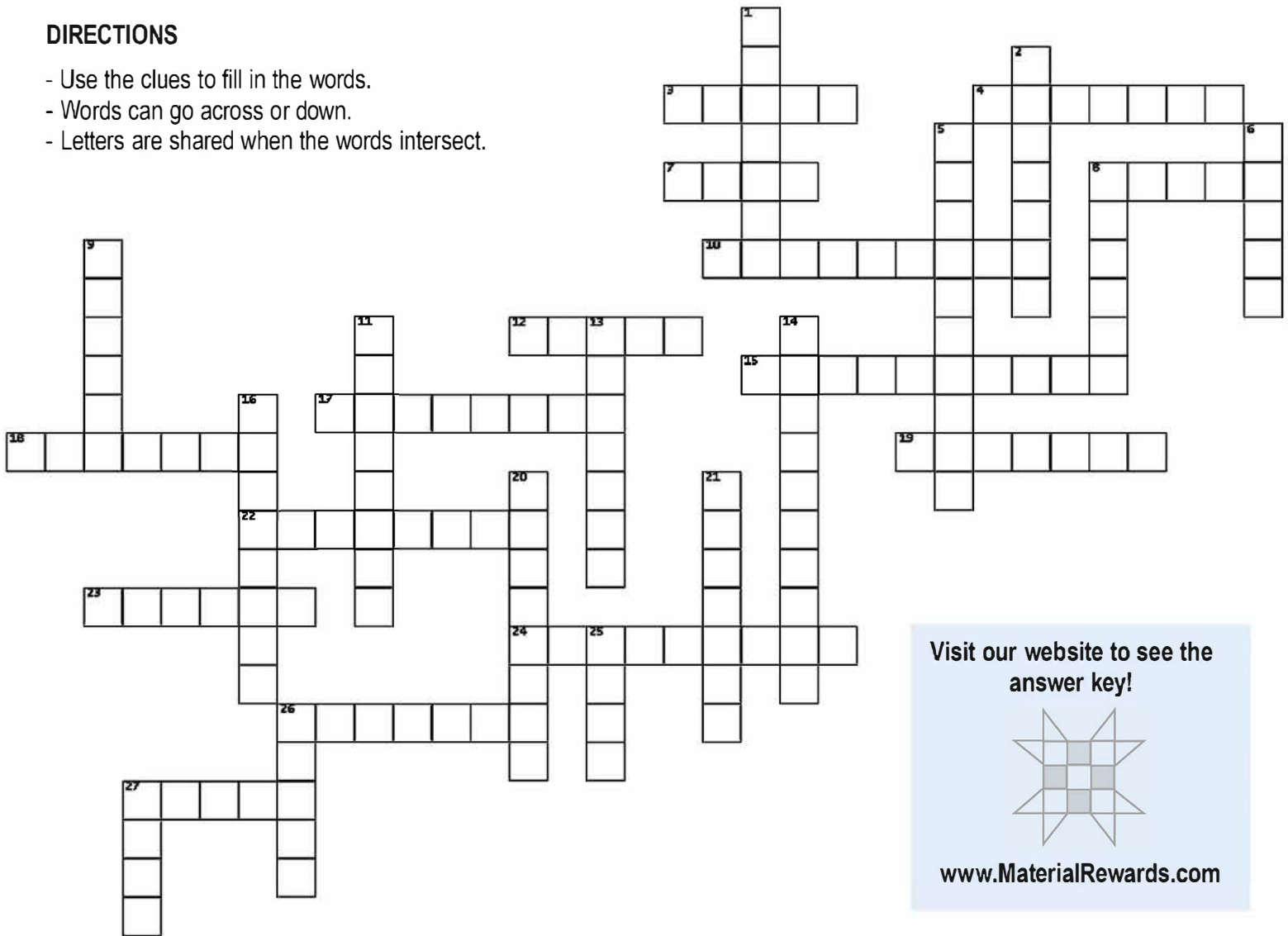


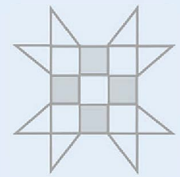
QUILTING CROSSWORD PUZZLE

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ACROSS

- A 5' x 5' square

- These sewing machines are manufactured in Switzerland

- Stitching fabric shapes onto a foundation block
- The bottom thread holder in a sewing machine
- To decorate with stitching
- Scissors that cut a zigzag edge
- Joining together a quilt sandwich with large stitches

- A quilt design featuring a variety of blocks
- Type of piecing where you stitch on the back side of the paper
- The basic unit of a quilt
- A product used to make fabric stiff
- Fabric that frames a quilting design
